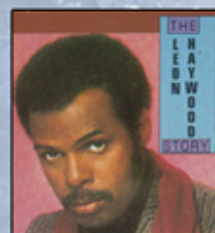

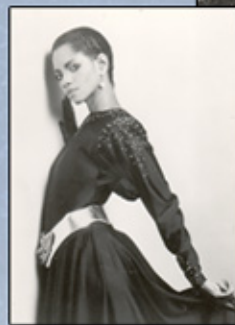

What Ever Happened To..? A one-hour weekend program What Ever Happened To..? targeted to Rhythm and Blues, Urban AC, Classic Soul, Oldies, Hip-Hop audiences with some Top 40 interest nation-wide grabbing a greater share of your market. There will be interviews of the artist themselves plus background singers, producers, managers, musicians, writers and even family members of R&B - Urban stars from the past in future programs.

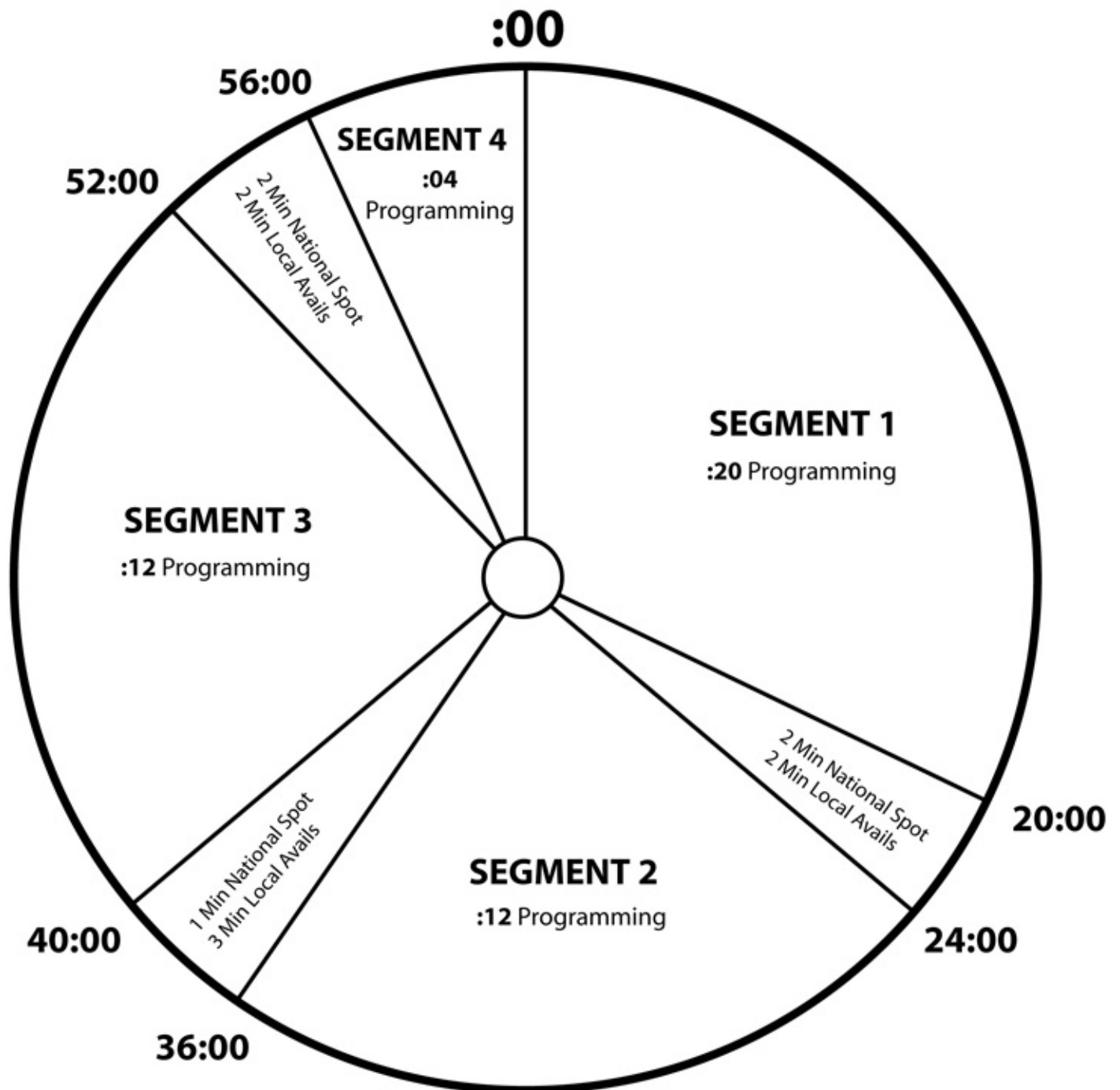

Prior to WLAC 'Spider' was program director at WTLC, Indianapolis and the native New Yorker interned at WWRL, New York where he was also a student announcer at WCWP, C W Post College in New York.

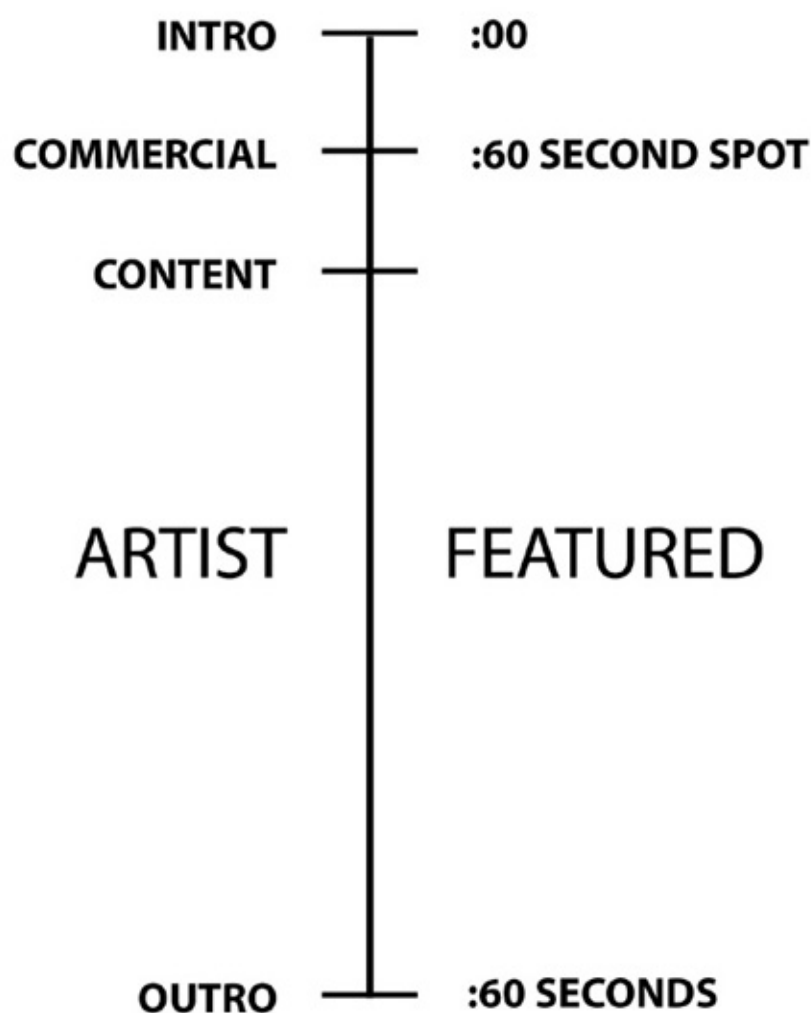
